
#### <u>The PFL USA Pet</u> <u>First Aid & CPR</u> <u>Course</u>

The Paws For Life USA First Aid and CPR Certificate course provides pet owners with a comprehensive overview of emergency preparedness and how to assemble a first aid and disaster preparedness kit. Attendees will learn to identify the signs of a life threatening-emergency, assess the situation. and either minimize the potential harm or treat the animal in danger. Scenarios presented include respiratory emergencies, fractures, bleeding wounds, toxin exposure, and insect and snakebites. Most importantly, pet owners will learn how to perform CPR on their domestic pets.

This course takes place once every month, is available to Paws For Life USA members free of charge, and costs \$80 for nonmembers. Attendees will need to bring a towel and a large mouthed stuffed dog or cat. The organization will provide the materials necessary to assemble a first aid kit.
